After learning more about the ownership groups and Whai Director of Coaching Alex Stojkovic's vision for basketball in the Bay of Plenty, I have no doubt the Whai are going to have a huge impact on the growth and development of basketball in the region."

Director of Coaching Stojkovic is thrilled to have Lacey on board to lead the inaugural season.
